#### Content

You will experience performance in a solo and/or ensemble/band context, depending on your specialism, with accompaniment provision (where appropriate). The practical application of orchestration/arranging and composition is emphasised through collaborative projects and workshops with instrumentalists.

With modules that prepare you for careers in education and community music, the university has one of the few music departments in the country to offer an undergraduate module in Music Therapy.
