You'll experience a variety of clinical placements and will learn using a diverse range of techniques and approaches. You'll undertake clinical practice for half of the course, in community and hospital placements as well as independent and voluntary sector experience.

During placements, you will be involved in nursing activities including providing care for a range of patients relevant to the nursing pathway you've chosen.
