This course introduces automotive engineering to those who are planning a career in the motor vehicle industry. The motor vehicle industry is developing at a fast rate and, as vehicles become increasingly technical, so do the skills and knowledge needed to service and maintain them. You will develop practical skills in a workshop environment, and learn theory and principles in the classroom.

The course includes:

General mechanics, including braking systems, engine, suspension, oils, lubricants, maintenance and servicing;
Awareness and safe practice when working with Electric and Hybrid vehicles; Health and safety; Communication, information technology, problem solving, team-working and numeracy
Work experience, placements, visits to industry and visits from experts.
