The MSc Banking and Finance course is suitable for everyone, whether you already have related qualifications or experience, or want to change the direction of your career. Students are encouraged to reflect on the benefits of a more ethical approach to banking and finance. You should be aware of the importance of sustainability in financial decision making, and in particular how social and environmental risk factors affect financial performance.
