This programme provides the opportunity for progression to a nursing degree (adult or mental health nursing) at UWS and other universities with a Scottish Wider Access Programme (SWAP) agreement. The course is challenging and considerable study will be required out with college time.

You will receive input from SWAP and UWS during the programme to support you to apply to university.
