The course will equip you with the skills to become a competent and efficient Chief Mate. You will require a total of 36 months 'watch-keeping service' while holding an OOW Unlimited II/I COC to undertake your next examination for Master (Unlimited) COC. This period may be reduced to 24 months if at least 12 months of such seagoing service has been served as Chief Mate while holding a Chief Mate unlimited, II/2, Certificate of Competency.
