Projects concentrate on designing, exploring and making, drawing and personal expression.

This course could provide you with a variety of work suitable for a portfolio with an emphasis on applied art techniques in Art Glass, Applied Ceramics, Jewellery, Textiles and Performance Costume. Although we teach making skills on the course, it's an advantage to have experience in working in 3D and also making skills in different media.

Art and design context: personal investigation; Creative project for artists and designers; Printmaking; Textiles; Developmental drawing portfolio; Ceramics project; Jewellery project; Art glass design and production.
