Additional Support Needs (ASN) covers many different circumstances and conditions that may require long or short term support for pupils. This can include a disability or health issue, family circumstances or social, emotional and behavioural factors. Working in an ASN role requires patience and sensitivity, as well as sometimes being firm. Although often hard work, it can also be very rewarding.

This course gives you the knowledge and practical skills you'll need to provide safe and effective care to children and young adults with ASN.

This course combines studying at college with hands on sector experience. Each week you'll spend 2 days in college and 2 days on a placement which supports people with ASN, such as a specialist base within a mainstream school, a specialist school or a community/social services care setting.

The qualification allows registration with SSSC as a practitioner along with SVQ at SCQF Level 7 .
