Content

This course is aimed at those who wish to gain employment as an early learning and childcare practitioner. This sector is expanding and demand for qualified early years staff is set to rise. The course will provide the learner with a wide knowledge of the factors which influence children's care and their learning and development. Students will gain an understanding of the principles, values and legislation underpinning early years practice. The course also provides opportunities to relate theory to practice with a practical placement of two days each week, which will give candidates the opportunity to see first-hand how early years settings operate.
