The Access to Health, Paramedics & Nursing course is a full or part time programme (part of the Scottish Wider Access Programme – SWAP) designed for adults with life experience who are ready to return to education and pursue a future in the health sector.

You'll develop the academic confidence, scientific knowledge and practical understanding needed for study and work in modern healthcare. Through a mix of theory, discussion and applied learning, you'll explore the values of the NHS, the science of the human body, and the emotional intelligence required to care for others in high-pressure environments.
