This course will prepare you for entering employment in the services. You will visit some of uniformed services establishments, such as a local fire station, police station, HMP YOI Grampian and the Army, where you will get to meet and talk with serving members of the uniformed services. You will get to see first-hand what their job roles are and the different types of career opportunities are available. There will be opportunities for some work experience with one or two of the uniformed services along with organised activities. You will also experience some outdoor activities such as land navigation, orienteering and expedition training.
