Content

If you are a registered adult nurse, this course means you can become a fully qualified midwife in just 20 months.

The Programme comprises 60% practice and 40% theory. Your clinical practice placements are provided by NHS Highland, NHS Western Isles, NHS Orkney, NHS Shetland and NHS Grampian in urban, remote and rural island practice areas. The theory components are arranged in blocks of attendance.

Content:

Semester 1: Transition to midwifery; Clinical practice 1.

Semester 2: Midwifery care of the mother and neonate(s) with complex needs; Clinical practice 2.

Semester 3: Being a midwife, 'Best Start' and the context of care; Clinical practice 3.
