Content

This course is highly practical, but with a theoretical element which is continuously assessed throughout the year. Comprising: 12 credits plus three core skills. Six of the units will be covered on both options, including plant identification, garden design, horticultural machinery and plant nutrition.

Applicants will have two choices:

Amenity Horticulture.

This option is highly plant orientated with subjects including: plant propagation, seed sowing and soft landscaping using trees and shrubs. Suitable for a possible career in garden maintenance or working in a garden centre or nursery.

Landscape Construction.

This includes landscape construction subjects such as: brickwork, paths and paving, drystone walling and fence construction. Option choices can be discussed further at interview and candidates will be entered for their preferred choice.
