Are drawing, painting and printmaking your creative strengths? This course is taught in our purpose-built studios and is designed to provide a high-level programme of study. You'll focus on developing your practical skills and conceptual thinking while exploring both traditional and contemporary approaches to working. The creative briefs you'll get to work on will stimulate your own art practice in original and unconventional ways, and you'll also get the chance to complete a short course at the Glasgow Print Studio.

Key elements of the HNC Fine Art: Painting and Printmaking course are:

Drawing - Observational, developmental and sketchbook work, including life drawing; Exploratory 2d painting; Printmaking; Screen-printing, dry point etching, mono and relief printing (wood and lino); Project work; Portfolio preparation and exhibition; Art theory and context, including gallery visits and artist talks; Graded Unit; self-directed project.


