### Content

This SWAP Access to Humanities (Primary Teaching) course is designed for adults returning to study who may not yet have the formal qualifications for a university teaching degree. It offers a supportive, structured route to refresh academic skills, develop confidence in communication and research, and explore how education, society and childhood are interconnected.

You'll engage with themes of learning, development, communication, society and change — gaining the academic habits needed for degree-level study in education, social sciences or humanities.

Topics include:

A range of social science subjects, including Psychology, Sociology and Politics, History and Philosophy, Communications and Literature (Higher level), Mathematics (National 5 Applications) and Preparation for Higher Education.

In preparation for Higher Education students will also develop study skills and research skills. Candidates will be assessed using essays, class-based exams and presentations.
