2026 entry requirements

Standard entry:

5 Highers at AAAAB including Chemistry at A and Biology (or Human Biology). If Biology (or Human Biology) at B, one from Maths, Computing Science, Economics, Geography or Physics at A required plus English at National 5 at B.





Widening access entry:

4 Highers at AABB including Chemistry at A and Biology (or Human Biology). If Biology (or Human Biology) at B, one from Maths, Computing Science, Economics, Geography or Physics at A required plus English at National 5 at B. (You may gain entry to the Gateway programme with 4 Highers at BBBB).

2nd year entry is possible with Advanced Higher Biology and Chemistry at A plus Highers at AAAAB.
