You must be working in a relevant environment, have the support of your employer, and meet the requirements Specified by the NMC. You must have National 4 English and Maths or Applications of Maths.

You must be sponsored by your employer (you can't fund yourself on this programme) and working in healthcare practice in a caring role. All applicants will undergo an interview and assessment of personal values as required by the NMC. Good health evidenced through self-declaration of health status, occupational health screening, review of previous sickness and absence record and two references, one of which must be from your current employer.
