This course, in collaboration with Queen Margaret University, is aimed at students with excellent acting skills who are looking to become professional actors in theatre, film and television.

Subjects include Advanced Acting Skills, Repertoire and Audition Technique, Showcase and Performance Project. The focus of the course is to shape and enhance your existing skills and knowledge, build your confidence, develop your business skills, and prepare you for a successful career in performing arts.
