This programme is specifically for young people (Interns) living in South Ayrshire aged 17 to 29, who have learning difficulties and/or are on the autistic spectrum. The focus is on preparing interns for work in the wider community. The programme develops the competitive, transferable and marketable skills needed for successful employment.

Interns will receive individualised instruction, coaching, support and feedback from their instructor, job coach, managers, and mentors.
