Entry Requirements

You must have a degree containing 80 SCQF credit points from at least two of the following subjects: Religious Studies; Philosophy; Theology; Divinity; Sociology of Religion; Anthropology of Religion; and Psychology of Religion. If you wish to teach specifically in a Catholic school, the 80 SCQF credit points must be from Religious Studies, Theology or Divinity, which may include a maximum of 20 credit points in Philosophy related to religion. 40 of the credit points must have been studied at SCQF Level 8 or above. You must also have Higher English plus Maths or Applications of Maths at National 5.

You require a satisfactory PVG (Protecting Vulnerable Groups) check to show you are suitable for this type of course. Contact Disclosure Scotland for details.
