The course focuses on safe, accurate, and efficient repair methods, preparing you for progression into employment, apprenticeships, or higher-level study.

Core learning areas include:

Body Repair Techniques – removing and refitting panels, straightening body structures, and repairing damage from dings and dents; Mechanical, Electrical, and Trim (M.E.T) – understanding how body systems connect and function; Welding and Joining – developing MIG welding and resistance spot welding skills; Plastic Bumper Repair and Finishing – welding and refinishing plastic components; Essential Theory and Testing – verbal knowledge assessments and IMI online multiple-choice tests.
