You will develop an understanding of the principles of design and gain knowledge of how floristry businesses operate and develop the skills required to interact with customers and to identify their needs.

Content includes:

Health and safety in land-based industries; Working in the floristry industry; Customer service; Caring for and maintaining floristry products; Prepare to create floristry designs; Creating floristry designs; Floristry design principles.

To be awarded the qualification the following must be achieved:

Theory exam; Synoptic assignment; Health and safety assignment; Evidence of 150 hours of a work experience
