This four-year BSc (Hons) Nursing course will prepare you with the knowledge, skills and leadership qualities for a successful and rewarding career in nursing. On completion students will be eligible to apply for registration with the NMC as a registered adult nurse.

Year 1: Exploring Nursing's Metaparadigm in a Local Context; Pre-Requisites for Person-Centred Practice 1; Exploring Care Environments; Person-Centred Processes in Nursing 1; Active Learning Communities 1.

Year 2: Analysing Nursing's Metaparadigm in a Global Context; Pre-Requisites for Person-Centred Practice 2; Developing Person-Centred Teams and Cultures; Person-Centred Processes in Nursing 2; Active Learning Communities 2.

Year 3: Applying Nursing's Metaparadigm in Person-Centred Contexts; Pre-Requisites for Person-Centred Practice 3; Developing as a Person-Centred Facilitator and Leader; Person-centred Processes in Nursing 3.

Year 4: Integrated Person-centred Nursing Practice for Human Flourishing; Dissertation/Workplace Project; Person-centred Assessment Skills.
