National 5 Maths, Biology and Chemistry at B, or relevant national qualifications at SCQF Level 5.

Applicants will have a personal interview and may be required to take a Maths skills test to gain entry onto the course. To be eligible to enrol as a SWAP Access student you should have been out of full-time education for at least 3 years if you have previous Level 5 qualifications, or 5 years if you already have SCQF Level 6 qualifications.
