This accredited degree by the Joint Board of Moderators (JBM), including major engineering institutions, meets academic requirements for registration as an Incorporated Engineer (IEng) and partly fulfils the academic criteria for Chartered Engineer (CEng) status.

Covering core Civil Engineering subjects, the Graduate Apprenticeship empowers apprentices to contribute effectively to planning, designing, and executing Civil Engineering projects. The curriculum emphasises the development of professional skills like teamwork, critical thinking, and creativity, aligning with the Skills Development Scotland Civil Engineering framework.

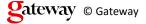
