You'll be introduced to subjects like counselling and human development, as well as learning about health, safety and child protection. During the Advanced Social Care (Level 6) course, your caring and professional care skills will be developed by studying subjects such as psychology, mental health, sociology, protection and safeguarding, behaviour and disability.

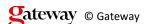
