### **Content**

#### Year 1:

You will study Chinese 1, an introduction to modern spoken and written Chinese, and Modern East Asia, an introduction to modern East Asian history. A range of other courses, including Modern China in Literature and Film, is available.

#### Year 2:

You will continue to learn Chinese and will explore Chinese culture further in Chinese 2A and Chinese 2B. You may also take Pre-Modern East Asia to 1600, to learn more about classical and pre-modern Chinese history and culture, in preparation for your year in China.

#### Year 3:

You will spend your third year in China where you will develop your language skills and follow courses in Chinese literature and culture.

#### Year 4:

You will continue to study Chinese language alongside your choice of courses in film, politics, modern and premodern history, literature, philosophy and economic history.
