This LANTRA Diploma at SCQF Level 5 provides those wishing to work in the veterinary and land-based sectors a nationally recognised qualification to enhance your ability to work safely, effectively, and efficiently in the workplace. Full time learners have blended learning with a range of theory teaching on campus and online with practical learning and a proportion of time in practical placement enhancing employability as well as furthering knowledge.
