Content

This Lifelong Learning course offers learning opportunities for adults who need additional support for learning. It aims to support personal development, self-determination and social inclusion. The course subjects consist of half-day sessions.

Cardonald Campus - Creative hub/Volunteering:

Learning to use materials to create items for sale; Learning new techniques to create craft items. You will also have the opportunity to volunteer in the college shop.

Langside Campus - Creative media.

Watch and listen to examples of media, like tv shows, adverts, songs, podcasts and videos

Look over stories and articles from newspapers and magazines; Learn how to make your own media, like drawing a comic, making a poster / advert, recording a short video or creating a simple podcast; Talk about how media can make people feel happy, excited or even help them learn new things.

Teaching takes place in informal small groups.
