Content

This course is designed for adults returning to study after at least 5 years out of full-time education.

You will have the opportunity to study a range of SQA Social Science units at SCQF Levels 5 and 6, alongside units in Communication, Mathematics and Information Technology.

The course also includes a class in 'Preparation for Higher Education' which, combined with guidance, aims to help you reach your full potential. The classes on offer are assessed by continuous assessment throughout the year.

Students wishing to go on to primary teaching will require to study and successfully complete a Mathematics examination at SCQF Level 5 and complete a placement in a primary school.

Course subjects include: Psychology; History; Modern Studies; Sociology; Geography; Philosophy; Communication; Mathematics or Numeracy; IT.
