Have you been out of education for some time and want to return to develop your knowledge and skills? Run in partnership with the Scottish Wider Access Programme (SWAP), this course considers the inequalities that exist within society (education, criminal justice system) as well as introducing you to the different ways that psychologists analyse and treat behaviour.

From history and criminology to psychology, you'll get a solid foundation in the social sciences, discovering how the world works from the point of view of social scientists. If you are interested in primary teaching you'll study National 5 Applications of Maths exam and undertake a work placement.

Course subjects include:

Psychology; History; Sociology; Criminology; Communication; Numeracy; IT; National 5 Application of Maths (only for those intending to apply for Primary Education or Social Work).

The course also includes a class in 'Preparation for Higher Education' which, combined with guidance, aims to help you reach your full potential. The classes on offer are assessed by continuous assessment throughout the year.
