Entry Requirements

This course is not aimed at recent school leavers. You must have a gap in your education of three years if you have previously studied at National 5, or equivalent level, or five years if you have previously studied at Higher/HNC level. If you have not

studied at National 5/Standard grade level previously, you should look into our NQ Applied Science Level 5 or Introduction to Science course (Level 4).

Due to the high level of Chemistry and Biology you will be expected to have some appropriate recent qualifications in these subjects and at least Maths at National 5, or equivalent. Grades from any recent part time courses you have undertaken will be taken into account when deciding on entry to the programme.
