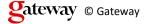

### **Entry Requirements**

2026 entry requirements

Standard entry:

5 Highers at AAAAB (first sitting) including Biology (Human Biology preferred) and Chemistry plus English and Maths at National 5 at B. Offers will be condition based on the attainments of 3 Advanced Highers or crash Highers at BBB in 6th year, including Biology or Chemistry.

Widening access entry:

Advanced Higher Biology or Chemistry at B plus 5 Highers at AAABB including Biology (preferably Human Biology) and Chemistry (at least one at Grade A) plus English and Maths at National 5 at B.

All applicants will be expected to undertake the UCAT test before they apply.

All potential dentistry students are required to undergo screening for blood borne viruses (Hepatitis B and C, and HIV). You will require a satisfactory criminal record check from Disclosure Scotland to show that you are suitable for this type of course. Contact Disclosure Scotland for details on the type you would need.
