Entry Requirements

2020 entry requirements:

Premedical (Non Science Route):

4 Highers at AAAB (minimum) but typically 5 Highers at AAAAB (first sitting) including not more than one science subject and excluding Chemistry plus English at National 5. Offers will be conditional on the attainment of 3 Advanced Highers or crash Highers in 6th year.

Premedical Widening Access:

4 or 5 Highers at ABBB or BBBBB including Chemistry and one other science subject plus English at National 5. Local school pupils with evidence of significant adversity.

All applicants will be expected to undertake the UCAT test before they apply.

All potential medical students are required to undergo screening for blood borne viruses (Hepatitis B and C, and HIV). You will require a satisfactory criminal record check from Disclosure Scotland to show that you are suitable for this type of course. Contact Disclosure Scotland for details on the type you would need.
