Contemporary fashion design in addition to digital fashion design; Approaches to tailoring and manufacturing; Bridal and Evening wear; Couture Embellishments; Advanced manufacturing skills including pattern and garment construction, textile technology and production processes; Theoretical studies including fashion merchandising and fashion forecasting.
