You will also develop a wide range of archaeological skills such as fieldwork, surveying and post-excavation, with an emphasis on the cultural heritage of the Highlands and Islands. These skills are mapped to the current occupational standards for archaeology, to increase your employability after graduation.

You will learn the theoretical aspects of Scottish history and archaeology through a combination of face-to-face and video conference seminars in the classroom, and online study via the university's virtual learning environment (VLE), supported by your tutors.
