### Content

Our course has three strands: The Pharmacist, The Patient, The Medicine, which are introduced separately and then become increasingly interlinked and developed over four years. The emphasis is on preparing graduates for a dynamic profession, and embedding the need for continuing professional development and life-long learning.

Year 1:

Foundations in Pharmacy Practice; Biological Science; Pharmaceutical Chemistry; Foundations in Medicine Design; Integrated Physiology.

Year 2:

Developing Pharmacy Practice; Biomolecular Pharmacy; Medicine Design and Manufacture; Pharmaceutical Microbiology; Clinical Pharmacology and Therapeutics 1.

Year 3:

Integrated Pharmacy Practice; Medicinal Analysis and Aseptic Control; Therapeutic Delivery; Clinical Pharmacology and Therapeutics 2; Project Introduction.

Year 4:

Consolidating Pharmacy Practice; Research Project; General Pharmaceutical Care Provision; Public Health for Pharmacists; Specialised Pharmaceutical Care Provision.
