### Content

First Year: Level 1 courses are An Introduction to Moral Philosophy; Knowledge and Mind; Reason and Argument.

Second Year: The Philosophy curriculum at level 2 is devoted to more advanced courses in Metaphysics, Philosophy of Language, and The History of Philosophy.

Third and Fourth Year (Honours): Single Honours Mental Philosophy involves independent study at level 3 and a (compulsory) dissertation at level 4. There is a wide range of options at both level 3 and 4. Options offered reflect the interests of members of staff and have recently included Political and Social Philosophy, Scientific Methodology, Philosophy of Mathematics, Philosophy of Humour, Modal Logic, The Ontology of Existence, Philosophy of Physics, Continental Rationalism, Kant, Identity and Persistence, Information and Philosophy, Philosophy of Biology, Kripke's Naming and Necessity, Death, Philosophy of Time, Scepticism, Metaphilosophy, Feminist Philosophy, Wittgenstein and Philosophy of Religion, Leibniz, and Berkeley.
