Content

First and Second Year: To qualify for entry to Honours in Scottish Studies, students must take at least one level 1 and one level 2 course in each of the three departments.

Third and Fourth Year (Honours): In the third and fourth years, students must gain at least three-quarters of the credits needed for the degree equally from studies in Gaelic, English and History. The remainder will normally come from one or more of these disciplines, and a dissertation will normally be written for one of them.
