The School of Management examines these operations and behaviours through the lens of responsible enterprise, focusing on the wider impact of organisations and their interactions with stakeholders within their local context and on a global scale.

Students with a degree in Management from the University of St Andrews will not only develop an understanding

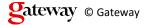
of how business and management function, they will also gain knowledge of markets, finance and accounting, strategy development, entrepreneurship, managing and developing people, creativity and policy.
