Content

This course prepares you work effectively in a range of care settings with a variety of service users. You will gain an understanding of the values and principles of social care and will learn how to integrate those values with the necessary skills and knowledge to develop as a Social Services Practitioner.

You'll learn about:

Approaches to assessment in social services; Developing reflective practice; Supporting individuals during transition, loss and changes; Health safeguarding welfare and rights; Promoting health safety and security in the work setting; Promoting effective communication.

This course also includes a mandatory work placement where you will be required to work shift patterns that may include evening/weekend hours. You will complete SVQ L3 units x 3 during placement where you will learn about: Promoting health, safety and security in the work setting; Developing your practice through reflection and learning; Promoting effective communication.
