Whether you're already working in a care setting and want to learn more, or you're interested in a career in social care, this course will give you a formal qualification to help you work anywhere in the sector - or progress to the next level of study.

It involves a social care work placement where you can learn practical skills combined with theory, helping you to understand the needs of different care settings and how to support people effectively. When you complete the course, you'll be a Scottish Social Services Council (SSSC) registered care practitioner.

Areas of study covered include:

Care in contemporary society; Leadership; Health, wellbeing and safeguarding; Lifespan development theoretical approaches; Promoting health, safety and security in the work setting; Developing your practice through reflection and learning; Promoting effective communication; Care practice.

To support your learning, you will also undertake a social care placement as part of the course.
