This course is for you if you are working within a playwork setting with children and young people as a Playwork Practitioner, as outlined in Scottish Social Services Council (SSSC) guidelines. You will be required to build a portfolio of evidence to demonstrate your competence and understanding of playwork theories and practice.

Subjects include: Provide a Child-centred Play Space; Promote the Development of Children and Young People Through Play; Promote Positive Relationships in the Play Setting; Health, Safety and Wellbeing of Children and Young People in the Play Environment; Working with Colleagues; Safeguarding Children and Young People; Reflect and Develop Practice.

There will be onsite assessment and you will be required to prepare a portfolio of evidence.
