The University has three campuses.

- The Dundee City Campus is compact and has everything you need on your doorstep. This includes the library, sports centre, teaching spaces, Student Union and more.
- Located three miles west of the City Centre Campus is Ninewells Campus. This is home to the University of Dundee's School of Medicine. It's situated within Ninewells Hospital, which is one of Europe's largest teaching hospitals.
- The Kirkcaldy Campus, located in Fife contains its own library, clinical skills centre, lecture theatre, and teaching rooms.
