UHI Inverness is the largest college in the Highlands and Islands, and the largest of the 13 academic partners of the University of the Highlands and Islands.

The college has its campus in Inverness, as well as the Scottish School of Forestry at Balloch, 7 miles from Inverness city centre.

The college offers more than 300 courses ranging from Access to degree and beyond and has around 6,000 students studying at Inverness College and around 800 staff.

Courses and subjects

Courses are available at all levels including introductory, NC, HNC, HND, degree and postgraduate. Industry and vocational qualifications are also on offer.

Courses are taught in the following subject areas: Business and Computing; Creative Industries; Education, Child and Youth Studies; Engineering, Construction and Technology; Gaelic Language and Culture; Health and Wellbeing; History, Heritage and Social Studies; Science, Nature and the Environment; and, Sports, Adventure and Tourism.

The new campus has a major sports complex which includes indoor tennis, all weather pitches, studios and games halls.
