Why study SfW Beauty?

There are a range of careers connected to the beauty industry.

Beauty consultants demonstrate and sell beauty products. Make-up artists design and apply make-up for actors on television, film or the stage. Electrologists use electrical treatments to remove unwanted hair permanently from the face and body. Nail technicians treat clients' nails, as well as applying and decorating artificial nails.

Entry is at the discretion of the school or college.


What will I study?

The course is made up of four compulsory units, each one taking 40 hours of study:

- Facial Techniques
- Facial Treatment Packages
- Nail Finishes
- Creative Current Make-up Trends

- · changing fashion and make-up trends





Where will I take the course?

You will usually train at a local college. Training sessions will take place for a set number of hours and weeks during term time.
