What do I need to get in?

Entry is at the discretion of the school or college.

What will I study?

The course is made up of four compulsory units, each one taking 40 hours of study.

- Working in Retail (6 SCQF credit points)
- Maintaining, Storing and Replenishing Stock (6 SCQF credit points)
- Satisfying Customer Needs (6 SCQF credit points)
- Planning and Implementing an Event (6 SCQF credit points)

You will learn about

- the nature of retailing as an industry and the variety of jobs on offer in the sector
- the legal requirements of pricing
- how good service and appropriate selling skills can improve sales
- developing your communication, planning and organising skills.

Where will I take the course?

You will usually train at your school or a local college. Training sessions will take place for a set number of hours

and weeks during term time.

Work experience/placements

You should be able to arrange a related work experience placement by speaking to your pastoral care or guidance teacher in school.

How will I be assessed?

Assessment will be based on a range of practical activities in real or simulated workplace settings. Tutors will observe and keep records of your work.
