Entry is at the discretion of the school or college.

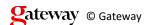
What will I study?

The course is made up of four compulsory units, each one with a value of 6 SCQF credit points.

- An Introduction to the Food and Drink Manufacturing Industry
- Food Science and Technology in the Food and Drink Manufacturing Industry
- Safety Requirements of the Food and Drink Manufacturing Industry
- Product Concept to Launch in the Food and Drink Manufacturing Industry.

You will learn about

- job roles in the industry and how they relate to one another
- the skills required for employment and promotion within the industry
- the routes food and drink take from field to table, including stages in the manufacturing process
- how products conform to quality and safety, and methods used to extend shelf life in products
- the legislation governing the industry and the need for compliance for food safety





how new products are developed, the drivers for change and consumer acceptance.

Where will I take the course?

You will usually train at a local college. Training sessions will take place for a set number of hours and weeks during term time.

Work experience/placements

You may be able to arrange a related work experience placement by speaking to your pastoral care or guidance teacher in school.

How will I be assessed?

Assessment will be based on a range of practical activities in real or simulated workplace settings. Tutors will observe and keep records of your work. Some assessment may be done online using an e-portfolio system.
